SUMMARY :

The Town Called and Ordered the General Election on January 20, 2026, to be held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Council Member Place 2 and Council Member Place 4 for two-year terms. In accordance with the Texas Election Code, results of the May 2, 2026 General Election must be canvassed based on official results no later than the 11th day after the election.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

The Mayor, Council Member Place 2 and Council Member Place 4 are elected in even-numbered years for two-year terms. The Town contracted with Tarrant County Elections to provide election services for the May 2, 2026 General Election (General Election) which included services for Westlake registered voters residing in Tarrant County and Denton County. Official results showing those candidates who were elected by the citizens of Westlake will be provided by Tarrant County Elections and be presented during the meeting. Unofficial results are being provided in this packet for informational purposes only. These results are subject to change pending certification. Ordinance 1046 has been prepared with the numbers from the unofficial results for the agenda item, and will be distributed prior to the meeting with the official numbers.

The returns of the General Election, including the returns of the absentee ballots, early voting ballots, and undervotes (race left blank by voter on ballot), showed that 406 voters participated in the election. The returns showed that each of the candidates received the following votes:

ORDINANCE NO. 1046

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WESTLAKE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 2, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR, COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 2 AND COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE 4 TO THE WESTLAKE TOWN COUNCIL TO TWO-YEAR TERMS EXPIRING MAY 2028

WHEREAS, the Town of Westlake, Texas, is a Type A general-law municipality located in Tarrant and Denton Counties, created in accordance with the provision of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council called and ordered the General Election on January 20, 2026 for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Council Member Place 2 and Council Member Place 4 to two-year terms to be held on May 2, 2026 (the “General Election”); and

WHEREAS, the General Election for the Town of Westlake was administered by the Tarrant County Elections Administrator, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that Notice of the Election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by the Texas Election Code, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas governing the holding of such elections; and

WHEREAS, the official returns of the General Election, including the returns of the absentee and early voting ballots, duly and legally made for electing a Mayor, Council Member Place 2 and Council Member Place 4 of the Town of Westlake Town Council have been presented to the Town Council and showed that each of the candidates received the following valid and legal votes cast at the election:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Texas Election Code, the candidate for election to each place on the Town Council who receives the highest number of all votes cast for all the candidates for each place at the election shall be declared elected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WESTLAKE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: CONFIRMATION OF VOTE TABULATIONS. The results of the General Election as related to the election of Mayor, Council Member Place Two and Council Member Place Four each for a two-year term to the Town of Westlake Town Council, as canvassed and tabulated above, reflect the expressed desires of the resident, qualified voters of the Town.

SECTION 2: ELECTION CANVASSED AND DECLARED EFFECTIVE. It is further found and determined that the results of the election are as canvassed and tabulated in the preamble hereof and in *Exhibit "A"* attached hereto.

SECTION 3: ELECTED OFFICIALS; TERMS OF OFFICE. In accordance with the canvass and tabulation of the results of the General Election, the duly elected Mayor and Council Members elected on May 2, 2026, and the corresponding terms of office, subject to the taking of the oaths of office as required by State Law, are declared elected as follows:

SECTION 4: TOWN SECRETARY TO RECORD ELECTION RESULTS. The Town Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to make the appropriate entries of information appearing in the tabulation of results shown in *Exhibit "A"* attached hereto, in the election register maintained by the Town in accordance with provisions of Section 67.006 of the Election Code.

SECTION 5: ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION: The Judge and/or Mayor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver Certificates of Election to the successful candidates elected at the General Election as specified in Section 3.

SECTION 6: TOWN STAFF TO TAKE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO GIVE EFFECT. The Town Manager, Town Secretary, and Town Attorney are hereby authorized and instructed to take all actions necessary to give effect to this ordinance and the election, as provided by law.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.
